



2015 NEW JERSEY BRED PROGRAM FOR PUREBRED ARABIANS IN HAND, PERFORMANCE AND DRESSAGE

will be held as part of the A-Rated NJHAHA CLASSIC Show
to be held June 12 - 14, 2015 at the Horse Park of New Jersey, Allentown, NJ*

ENTRY INFORMATION AND FORMS

- To be eligible for Jersey Bred year-end awards, a horse must be entered, shown and judged in at least three different NJ shows - Arabian or open - per category entered.
- Dressage scores from any dressage schooling show or USDF recognized show – Arabian or open - in New Jersey can be counted.
- Eligible horses must be nominated annually for awards. There is no fee. Nomination forms must be submitted to Kara Stark McGrew by June 12, 2015.

- Senior Mares – 6 Years & Over
- Junior Colts/Geldings – 5 Years & Under
- Senior Geldings – 6 Years & Over
- Senior Stallions – 6 Years & Over

- Sport Horse – Geldings, All Ages

2015 PUREBRED ARABIAN JERSEY BRED RULES

Eligibility

- Horses must a) be New Jersey bred and b) have a "New Jersey Bred Permanent Certification – Non Racing Breed" certificate, issued at no fee (see attached **Owners Eligibility Declaration for New Jersey Bred Horses**), to participate in the Jersey Bred Year Awards Program.

Fees

- Fees have been waived for 2015.

Nominations

- Horses must be nominated annually. Nominations should be sent by June 1, 2015 by e-mail (confirmation of receipt will be sent via e-mail), by fax, or by US Mail (include S.A.S.E if you would like a conformation of receipt). Do NOT send CERTIFIED Mail. NO TELEPHONE entries will be accepted.
- At least one owner must be a member of AHSNJ, in good standing (dues paid), at the time of nomination. The owner, lessee or purchaser (with an installment plan) that is making the nomination must adhere to the membership requirement. (Lessee and/or purchaser-on-installment must furnish copies of contracts). In the case of a horse being sold after nomination, the horse's nomination MUST be transferred to the new owner and a \$5 fee per category must be paid by the new owner in order to keep the horse in the program. Year-end prize money will be paid to the individual recorded as owner on the nomination form.
- Horse must be recorded under the exact name and number as registered with the Arabian Horse Association registry.

Shows

- Points won at New Jersey Arabian shows in May and June, 2015, as well as open shows in New Jersey, can be counted for the 2015 program.**
- A HORSE MUST BE ENTERED, SHOWN AND JUDGED at the NJHAHA CLASSIC SHOW, JUNE 12-14, 2015, IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR JERSEY BRED YEAR END AWARDS.** Points earned in classes designated "NJ" in the 2015 prize list can be used toward year-end awards.
- A HORSE MUST BE ENTERED, SHOWN, AND JUDGED IN AT LEAST THREE (3) DIFFERENT NEW JERSEY SHOWS (One MUST be the NJHAHA Classic Concurrent) IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR JERSEY BRED YEAR END AWARDS (1 per category entered).**

Point Returns

- DEADLINE FOR POINT RETURNS: NOVEMBER 1.** Points must be tabulated by the owner, on the correct form. Points will NOT be

considered if postmarked/e-mailed/faxed after November 1, or if illegible. Incorrect Point Return Forms will be returned to the owner, and must be resubmitted correctly by the November 1 deadline. Point returns should be sent by e-mail (confirmation of receipt will be sent), by fax, or by US Mail (include S.A.S.E. if you would like a conformation of receipt.) Do NOT send CERTIFIED. Please include a copy of AHA Competition Report, available on line, verifying placings for all shows.

- You should report the points from your three (3) best shows. Must be under three (3) different judges. An additional show(s) should be reported for tie breaking purposes (Tie-breakers need not be under a different judge). **You MUST list 3 shows**, whether the horse placed or not. Points may be used from any USEF rated Arabian Division or open show in New Jersey. You may use out-of-state shows, provided you have also shown in three (3) New Jersey shows. Regionals, East Coast and Nationals do not qualify for points and can NOT be submitted. Any falsification will be grounds for disqualification, with all winnings forfeited.
- Dressage scores from any schooling or USDF recognized dressage show – Arabian or open - held in NJ can be used.
- In order to earn points in a class, there must be at least TWO (2) horses entered, shown and judged in that class.
- You may NOT use Show/Grand Champion or Reserve in halter classes, unless the show does not offer Junior/Senior Championships.
- Points will not be accepted from any show that does not require a current negative Coggins test.
- AHSNJ is the sponsoring breed organization for purebred Arabians in the Jersey Bred program. If any of the conditions set down by the committee are not met, all prizes may be forfeited without remuneration of any and all fees.
- Disputes over points/placings will be adjudicated by the committee, and all decisions made by the committee will be final.

17. 2015 A-Rated Arabian shows in New Jersey in which eligible horses can earn points:

- **NJHAHA I and II Concurrent** - May 15 - 17 (A concurrent show which counts as *two* shows, each judge's placing counting as a separate show.)
- **NJHAHA Classic** - June 12 - 14

OWNERS ELIGIBILITY DECLARATION FOR NEW JERSEY BRED HORSES

Please complete this form, to verify that your horse is New Jersey Bred, and eligible to participate in the New Jersey Bred All Breed Show; and eligible for nomination into the Jersey Bred Year End Awards program. Please send completed form and a copy of the horse's Registration Papers to the Jersey Bred Chairperson listed below. Upon receipt of this form, you will be sent a "NEW JERSEY BRED PERMANENT CERTIFICATION – NON RACING BREEDS" Certificate. This certificate will be the horse's permanent proof of eligibility, & need not be done each year.

DO NOT SEND THIS FORM IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A CERTIFICATE

A NEW JERSEY BRED HORSE IS DEFINED AS:

1. Any foal dropped in the state of New Jersey, except for transient mares. A mare will be considered to be a transient mare if she does not reside in the State of New Jersey for at least 120 consecutive days, including the day of foaling. The owner of a mare may be asked to submit proof of such residence to the individual breed group; (or)
2. Any foal resulting from an embryo transfer from a mare who resides 120 consecutive days in the State of New Jersey, providing blood typing of the mare, stallion, and foal is carried out to authenticate parentage; and embryo transfer is agreeable to the national registry of the breed. A mare must donate only in New Jersey; (or)
3. The get of any stallion standing in New Jersey the full breeding season of the year in which the foal was conceived. Stallions standing in New Jersey must breed only in New Jersey for any yearly breeding season; (or)
4. Foals resulting from transport of semen from a stallion standing the full season in the State of New Jersey: a) providing blood typing of the stallion, mare, and foal is carried out to authenticate parentage; and b) semen transport is agreeable to the national registry of the breed.

2015 NEW JERSEY BRED ARABIAN SUPERIOR ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The purpose of this program is to recognize New Jersey bred horses that have successfully participated in their respective breed's show program and have proven themselves to be a superior individual in either conformation, performance, or both. Also, it is to recognize the New Jersey bred horses that have successfully achieved the **Legion of Merit, Supreme Legion of Honor, Supreme Legion of Merit, of a National Top Ten and/or Regional Champion or Reserve Championship.**

- One horse per breed group per year may receive this award.
 - All nominations must be in the office of the Department of Agriculture by November 1.
 - All nominations must be sent to your Awards Committee Chairperson for review, prior to being sent to Trenton.
1. Horse must be New Jersey bred, as defined by Equine Advisory Board rules, and nominated by the breed group.
 2. No competition, show, event, or activity prior to 1980 will be recognized for this program.
 3. Horse must be registered with one of the breed groups recognized by the Equine Advisory Board, but the owner need not be a member of any club or organization to qualify.
 4. Award requirements for each breed group must be first accepted by the breeders Awards Committee and reviewed annually.
 5. Any New Jersey bred horse that does not compete within it's own breed, but has proven to be superior on an individual basis, and New Jersey bred mares and stallions that have produced superior progeny are eligible.
 6. A horse can only win this award once. A winning horse may be deceased.
 7. A resume of the total achievements of any horse being considered for this award must be submitted to the chairperson of their breed group.
 8. Awards will be presented at the annual banquet.
 9. All nominations must be in the office of the Department of Agriculture by November 1.
 10. All nominations must be sent to your Awards Committee Chairperson for review, prior to being sent to Trenton.
